


Urban Albedos

Raise the Roof on Urban Heat

The picture below shows the albedos of different materials found in urban environments. Albedo is the amount of incoming sunlight that is reflected by a surface. Surfaces with an albedo close to 1.0 reflect almost all energy. Surfaces with an albedo close to zero absorb most of the sunlight, holding heat in the city.
